OVERVIEW: The Proposed Committee Substitute (PCS) for Senate Bill 572 would authorize public universities to obtain liability insurance for alcohol sales.

CURRENT LAW: Effective June 26, 2019, public universities are authorized to allow certain alcohol permits to be issued to stadiums and athletic facilities on their campuses.

BILL ANALYSIS: The PCS for Senate Bill 572 would clarify that a public university is authorized to obtain liability insurance to cover the sale or serving of alcohol on the public university's campus or at a facility leased or owned by the public university.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act would be effective when it becomes law.
