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OVERVIEW: Section 6.1 of this act amends G.S. 143B-434.01(b) by changing the recipients of the Comprehensive Strategic Economic Development Plan annual update sent each year by the Secretary of Commerce.

This section became effective July 1, 2020.

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 143B-434.01(b) requires the Secretary of Commerce to review and update the Comprehensive Strategic Economic Development Plan (Plan) each year and provide a copy of the current Plan and each annual update to the Governor and the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations.

BILL ANALYSIS: Section 6.1 of this act requires the Secretary of Commerce to send the Comprehensive Strategic Economic Development Plan annual update to the Governor, the chairs of the Senate Appropriations Committee on Agriculture, Natural, and Economic Resources, the chairs of the House of Representatives Appropriations Committee on Agriculture and Natural and Economic Resources, and the Joint Legislative Economic Development and Global Engagement Oversight Committee, and removes the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations as a recipient.
