OVERVIEW: *Section 3D.8 of S.L. 2020-33 allows licensed hospitals, nursing homes, and clinics to dispense controlled substances at additional business locations, provided they followed a registration process developed by the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services of the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services.*

This section became effective May 4, 2020, and expires 60 days after Executive Order No. 116 is rescinded, or December 31, 2020, whichever is earlier.
