OVERVIEW: Senate Bill 801 (S801) appropriates funds to the Military Presence Stabilization Fund.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** S801 appropriates from the General Fund a sum sufficient in recurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to the Military Presence Stabilization Fund to be used to sustain and maintain the State's military programs and activities by providing grants for local communities or military installations, updates to strategic planning, federal advocacy, and identification of measures to increase the military value of installations.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** S801 becomes effective July 1, 2020.
