OVERVIEW: Senate Bill 806 (S806) provides funds for certain capital improvements at Western Carolina University.

BILL ANALYSIS: S806 does the following:

- Sections 1 & 2 direct the State Controller to transfer \$11,585,462 from the cash balance in the Repairs and Renovations Reserve in G.S. 143C-4-3 and \$4,914,538 from the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (FICA) Fund to Western Carolina University and appropriates the funds to be used for the steam plant project at the University.
- Sections 3 & 4 are boilerplate language providing that (i) the State Budget Act is not superseded by this act and (ii) other bills enacted during the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly appropriating funds remain in effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: S806 becomes effective July 1, 2020.
