



# SENATE BILL 811: Connect NC Park Facilities Operating Reserves.

**OVERVIEW:** *S.L. 2020-42 transfers funds from the Pay Plan Reserve and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund to the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources for up to 19 full-time equivalent positions, equipment, and other nonrecurring expenses for State parks expanded or improved through Connect NC bonds.*

*This act became effective July 1, 2020.*

## **BILL ANALYSIS:**

Section 1(a) reallocates \$1,828,982 in recurring funds from the Pay Plan Reserve for the 2020–2021 fiscal year to the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources to be used to fund up to 19 full time equivalent positions and operational needs for State parks expanded or improved through Connect NC bonds.

Section 1(b) transfers \$750,000 in nonrecurring funds from the Park and Recreation Trust Fund to the Division of Parks and Recreation for equipment and other nonrecurring expenses for State parks expanded or improved through Connect NC bonds.

Sections 2 and 3 include conforming and clarifying language for this act with respect to the State Budget Act.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act became effective July 1, 2020.
