OVERVIEW: *Senate Bill 812 (S812) appropriates funds for the Agricultural Sciences Center (Center).*

BILL ANALYSIS: S812 does the following:

- Section 1 appropriates a sum sufficient of recurring and nonrecurring funds from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services to be used as follows:
 - Fund a full-time manager position for the Center.
 - Fund equipment, moving costs, and other nonrecurring expenses associated with opening the Center.
- Sections 2 and 3 are boilerplate language providing that (i) the State Budget Act is not superseded by this act and (ii) other bills enacted during the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly appropriating funds remain in effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: S812 becomes effective July 1, 2020.
