



SENATE BILL 813: UNC Building Reserve/Certain Project/FY 20-21.

OVERVIEW: *SB 813 appropriates funds and allows funds from the E-Commerce Reserve Fund and the Project Collect Tax to be used for the University of North Carolina Building Reserve for the operation and maintenance of certain building projects at constituent institutions.*

BILL ANALYSIS:

Section 1 (i) transfers \$8,500,000 in nonrecurring funds from the E-Commerce Reserve Fund and \$3,991,578 in nonrecurring funds from the Revenue: Project Collect Tax to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina (UNC) that are then appropriated for the UNC Building Reserve, (ii) appropriates \$118,289 in nonrecurring funds from the General Fund for the UNC Building Reserve, and (iii) sets forth the allocation of the funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to each constituent institution for the operation and maintenance of specific projects by project amount as follows:
