OVERVIEW: *Senate Bill 814 (S814) appropriates funds for the NC Promise Tuition Plan.*

BILL ANALYSIS: S814 does the following:

- Section 1 (i) appropriates a sum sufficient in recurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of the University of North Carolina to use for the NC Promise Tuition Plan and (ii) appropriates departmental receipts up to the amount needed to implement the act.
- Section 2 states the intent of the General Assembly to appropriate additional funds to "buy down" financial obligations incurred by Elizabeth City State University, the University of North Carolina at Pembroke, and Western Carolina University, for the NC Promise Tuition Plan.
- Sections 3 and 4 are boilerplate language providing that (i) the State Budget Act is not superseded by this act and (ii) other bills enacted during the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly appropriating funds remain in effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: S814 becomes effective July 1, 2020.
