**OVERVIEW:** *Senate Bill 816 (S816) appropriates funds to fully fund enrollment growth at North Carolina's community colleges.*

**BILL ANALYSIS:** S816 does the following:

- Section 1 (i) appropriates a sum sufficient in recurring funds from the General Fund to the Community Colleges System Office to be used to fully fund enrollment growth at North Carolina's community colleges and (ii) appropriates departmental receipts up to the amount needed to implement the act.
- Sections 2 and 3 are boilerplate language providing that (i) the State Budget Act is not superseded by this act and (ii) other bills enacted during the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly appropriating funds remain in effect.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** S816 becomes effective July 1, 2020.
