OVERVIEW: HB 12 would provide school calendar flexibility for Alamance-Burlington Schools until the conclusion of the 2022-2023 school year.

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 115C-84.2 provides that, with certain exceptions, the opening date for students in a school calendar must be no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26, and the closing date for students must be no later than the Friday closest to June 11.

BILL ANALYSIS: HB 12 would exempt Alamance-Burlington Schools from the opening and closing date requirements of G.S. 115C-84.2, providing the Alamance-Burlington Board of Education with flexibility to determine opening and closing dates for students through the conclusion of the 2022-2023 school year.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The bill would be effective when it becomes law and would expire at the conclusion of the 2022-2023 school year.
