OVERVIEW: *Section 2.1 of S.L. 2022-71 removes references to a specific student information system application used for reporting educational data and substitutes in its place the term "student information system."*

This section became effective July 8, 2022.

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 115C-12(18)e. requires, when practicable, reporting requirements developed by the State Board of Education as part of the Uniform Education Reporting System to be incorporated into the PowerSchool application or any other component of the Instructional Improvement System.

BILL ANALYSIS: This section of the act removes the reference to the specific PowerSchool application in G.S. 115C-12(18)e. and instead refers to "school information system."

EFFECTIVE DATE: Section 2.1 of S.L. 2022-71 became effective July 8, 2022.
