**OVERVIEW:** House Bill 180 would designate August 31st of each year as Overdose Awareness Day.

CURRENT LAW: Chapter 103 of the General Statutes designates various special days including:

- G.S. 103-7. American Family Day.
- G.S. 103-9. Prisoner of War Day.
- G.S. 103-10. Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day.
- G.S. 103-13. Fragile X Awareness Day.
- G.S. 103-14. Lineman Appreciation Day.
- G.S. 103-15. Posttraumatic stress injury awareness.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** House Bill 180 would designate August 31st of each year as Overdose Awareness Day in North Carolina.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** The act would be effective when it becomes law.
