OVERVIEW: Section 5 of S.L. 2021-160 exempts veterans separated under honorable conditions from needing a Mountain Heritage Trout fishing license while fishing in waters designated by the Wildlife Resources Commission (WRC) as Mountain Heritage Trout waters.

This section became effective October 1, 2021.

BILL ANALYSIS:

Section 5 of S.L. 2021-160 exempts veterans separated under honorable conditions from needing a Mountain Heritage Trout fishing license while fishing in waters designated by WRC as Mountain Heritage Trout waters. To qualify for this exemption, a veteran is required to always have valid documentation of their service on his or her person during the fishing activity.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective October 1, 2021.
