Wildlife Resources Commission Amendments, Sec. 8A:

Extend Eligibility for Reduced Price Lifetime Hunting and Fishing Licenses to Rescue Squad and EMS

OVERVIEW: Section 8A of S.L. 2021-160 extends eligibility for reduced price lifetime hunting and fishing licenses to members of a volunteer rescue squad or emergency medical services squad, who have served for five consecutive years, including the prior year.

This section became effective September 20, 2021.

PRIOR LAW/BILL ANALYSIS:

Section 12 of S.L. 2019-204 provided that eligible members of a volunteer fire department that have served for five consecutive years, including the prior year, may be issued any adult resident lifetime license issued and administered by WRC for 50% of the applicable license fee amount.

Section 8A of S.L. 2021-160 extends eligibility for reduced price lifetime hunting and fishing licenses to members of a volunteer rescue squad or emergency medical services squad, who have served for five consecutive years, including the prior year.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective September 20, 2021.
