OVERVIEW: House Bill 278 would sunset eligibility for participation in the Local Governmental Employees' Retirement System (LGERS) by Alcohol Control Boards.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 278 would amend G.S. 128-23 to provide that any ABC board that is not a participating employer in the LGERS on June 30, 2021, is not eligible to participate in the system.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act is effective when it becomes law.
