OVERVIEW: *The Proposed Committee Substitute (PCS) for House Bill 672 would direct the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety to study the preservation of biological evidence.*

BILL ANALYSIS: The PCS for House Bill 672 would direct the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety to study the preservation of biological evidence and report to the 2022 Regular Session of the 2021 General Assembly.

The study shall include topics enumerated in the bill, including a comparative analysis of how federal law and other states preserve, store, and destroy biological evidence and conduct an analysis as to the best methods for storing and preserving biological evidence.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act would be effective when it becomes law.
