OVERVIEW: S.L. 2021-84 eliminates provisions that broadly criminalize violations of rules of certain licensing boards and commissions and makes technical and conforming amendments in the surrounding language, as recommended by the General Statutes Commission.

This act became effective December 1, 2021, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.

BILL ANALYSIS: This act eliminates language that criminalizes a violation of any rule of the following commissions and boards:

Section 1: State Banking Commission adopted under the N.C. Consumer Finance Act,

Section 2: Cemetery Commission adopted under the N.C. Cemetery Act,

Section 3: Private Protective Services Board,

Section 4: Alarm Systems Licensing Board,

Section 5: State Board of Examiners of Electrical Contractors,

Section 6: State Board of Dental Examiners,

Section 7(b): State Board of Examiners in Optometry,

Section 8: State Board of Examiners for Nursing Home Administrators,

Section 9: State Board of Environmental Health Specialist Examiners,

Section 10: Medical Care Commission adopted under Part 2 of the Hospital Licensure Act and,

Section 11: Medical Care Commission adopted under the Nursing Home Licensure Act.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act became effective December 1, 2021, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
