OVERVIEW: *The PCS for H 731 would allow boards of county commissioners, or a designee, to set maximum rates for adult day care and adult day health services funded by the Home and Community Care Block Grant and the State Adult Day Care Fund.*

BILL ANALYSIS: The bill disregards laws the contrary concerning maximum rates and allows boards of county commissioners, or a designee, to set maximum rates for adult day care and adult day health services funded by the Home and Community Care Block Grant and the State Adult Day Care Fund.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The bill would become effective when it becomes law.
