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**OVERVIEW:** *House Bill 733 would increase the number of consecutive terms a member of the Advisory Council on Rare Diseases may serve.*

**BILL ANALYSIS:** Members appointed to the Advisory Council on Rare Diseases would serve for no more than three consecutive terms. The previous limit was no more than two consecutive terms.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act would be effective when it became law and apply to current members of the Advisory Council on Rare Diseases.

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
