

HOUSE BILL 911:

Regulatory Reform Act of 2022, Sec. 1: Clarify Requesting Board for Residency License

OVERVIEW: Section 1 of S.L. 2022-75 clarifies that charter school boards can request that an individual be issued a residency license.

This section became effective July 12, 2022, and applies to individuals seeking licensure on or after that date.

PRIOR LAW & BILL ANALYSIS:

<u>G.S. 115C-270.20</u> establishes the residency license for teachers – a one-year license, renewable twice for certain qualified teachers. The residency license must be requested by a local board of education and accompanied by a certification of supervision from a recognized educator preparation program in which the individual is enrolled.

Section 1 of S.L. 2022-75 clarifies that charter school boards can request that an individual be issued a residency license by changing the phrase "local board of education" in G.S. 115C-270.20 to "governing body of a public school unit."

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective July 12, 2022, and applies to individuals seeking licensure on or after that date.
