

HOUSE BILL 911: Regulatory Reform Act of 2022, Sec. 13: Waterslide Dispatcher Change

OVERVIEW: Section 13 of S.L. 2022-75 defines "waterslide dispatcher" as an employee stationed at the top of a waterslide for the purpose of managing the ride queue and dispatching waterslide users and provides that waterslide dispatchers must be at least 16 years of age.

This section became effective July 12, 2022.

CURRENT LAW & BILL ANALYSIS:

The Amusement Device Safety Act of North Carolina defines "operator" to mean a person having direct control of the operation of an amusement device and requires that an operator of a device subject to the Act's provision be at least 18 years of age.

Section 13 of S.L. 2022-75 defines "waterslide dispatcher" as an employee stationed at the top of a waterslide for the purpose of managing the ride queue and dispatching waterslide users and provides that waterslide dispatchers must be at least 16 years of age.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective July 12, 2022.
