OVERVIEW: Section 14 of S.L. 2022-75 allows counties and cities to enter into agreements to provide installation-support with military installations, consistent with federal law.

This section became effective July 12, 2022.

CURRENT LAW & BILL ANALYSIS:

10 U.S.C. §2679 authorizes the Secretaries of the Army, Navy, Air Force, or Homeland Security to enter into intergovernmental support agreements with State or local governments.

Sections 14(a) and 14(b) allow counties and cities, respectively, to enter into agreements to provide installation-support with military installations.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective July 12, 2022.
