

## SENATE BILL 105: 2021 Appropriations Act, Sec. 9B.8C: Funds for the Creation of a Continuing Medical Education Program on PANS/PANDAS

OVERVIEW: Section 9B.8C of S.L. 2021-180 requires that of the funds appropriated to the Division of Central Management and Support, Department of Health and Human Services, \$1,500,000 in nonrecurring funds must be allocated as a direct grant to the North Carolina Medical Society. The Medical Society must use those funds to award a grant to the Foundation for Children with Neuroimmune Disorders. The Foundation is required to use the funds to create a continuing medical education program for North Carolina physicians on Pediatric Acute-Onset Neuropsychiatric Syndrome (PANS) and Pediatric Autoimmune Neuropsychiatric Disorders Associated with Streptococcal Infections (PANDAS).

This section became effective July 1, 2021.
