

SENATE BILL 105: 2021 Appropriations Act, Sec. 9B.8: Funds for the Statewide Telepsychiatry Program

OVERVIEW: Section 9B.8 of S.L. 2021-180 provides that of funds appropriated from the State Fiscal Recovery Fund to the Office of Rural Health, Division of Central Management and Support, Department of Health and Human Services, \$1.5 million in nonrecurring funds for the 2021-2022 fiscal year must be allocated as a grant to the East Carolina University Center for Telepsychiatry and e-Behavioral Health for the statewide telepsychiatry program, known as NC-Step. The grant funds must be used to respond to COVID-19 public health emergency by providing virtual psychiatric assessments and consultations to patients utilizing telepsychiatry (as defined in G.S. 143B-139.4B).

The ECU Center for Telepsychiatry and e-Behavioral Health must report to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services and the Fiscal Research Division on the use of grant funds by July 1, 2022

This section became effective July 1, 2021.
