OVERVIEW: Senate Bill 126 would abolish obsolete boards and commissions that are no longer functional.

BILL ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 126 would abolish all of the following boards and commissions:

- The Board of Directors of the Certification Entity for the Phase II Settlement Funds.
- The North Carolina Agency for Public Telecommunications.
- The Charlotte Douglas International Airport Commission.
- The Board of Directors of the Charlotte Regional Partnership.
- The Commission on School Technology.
- The Data Integration Steering Committee.
- The Grants Management Oversight Committees.
- The Legislative Commission on Methamphetamine Abuse.
- The North Carolina Community Development Council.
- The North Carolina Farmworker Council.
- The Southern Growth Policies Board.
- The State Advisory Council on Employment Security.
- The State Suggestion Review Committee.
 - o The functions of this Committee are reassigned to the Office of State Human Resources.
- The Statewide Portal Committee.
- The Wholesale Distributor Advisory Committee.
- The Motor Vehicle Dealers' Advisory Board (effective June 30, 2023).
- The Blount Street Historic District Oversight Committee.

EFFECTIVE DATE: Except as otherwise provided, this act would be effective when it becomes law.
