OVERVIEW: *S.L. 2021-32 amends the anatomical gifts process (organ, eye, and tissue donation) to clarify that a statement or symbol indicating the individual has made an anatomical gift remains on the donor's drivers license or identification card until the donor revokes consent by requesting removal in a manner prescribed by the Division of Motor Vehicles. The act also provides that an individual who became a donor in another state and applies for a drivers license or identification card in North Carolina is required to authorize that a statement or symbol be imprinted on the donor's license or card issued in this State in order for the anatomical gift to be valid.*

The act became effective October 1, 2021.
