



SENATE BILL 212: Bennett College Accredit./Private Need-Based.

OVERVIEW: *S.L. 2021-15 allows students who attend private institutions of higher education in the State to qualify for the need-based scholarships as long as the institution they attend is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) or was accredited by SACSCOC on January 1, 2021, and also, beginning January 1, 2021, was a member of the Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools.*

This act became effective April 27, 2021, and applies beginning with scholarships awarded for the 2021-2022 academic year.

BILL ANALYSIS: S.L. 2021-15 allows a student who attends a private institution of higher education to qualify for the need-based scholarship as long as the institution they attend is accredited by SACSCOC or was accredited by SACSCOC on January 1, 2021, and also, beginning January 1, 2021, was a member of the Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act became effective April 27, 2021, and applies beginning with scholarships awarded for the 2021-2022 academic year.
