OVERVIEW: Senate Bill 235 (S235) appropriates funds for the operation of the new State Veterans Home in Kernersville for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.

BILL ANALYSIS: Beginning with the 2020-2021 fiscal year, S235 appropriates up to the sum of sixty-six thousand four hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$66,439) from the State Veterans Home Trust Fund to the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs to establish a full-time equivalent position to represent the State's interests and be responsible for State-owned assets as the new State Veterans Home in Kernersville becomes operational.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act is effective when it becomes law.
