

SENATE BILL 248: Additional Info on Health Insurance Cards.

OVERVIEW: S.L. 2021-30 requires health insurers to note on their insurance cards whether the plan is fully insured or self-funded.

This act became effective January 1, 2022, and applies to contracts entered into, amended, or renewed on or after that date.

BILL ANALYSIS: The act requires health benefit plans, including the State Health Plan, to state on their insurance cards whether the plan is fully insured or self-funded.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act became effective January 1, 2022, and applies to contracts entered into, amended, or renewed on or after that date.
