**OVERVIEW:** *S.L. 2021-30 requires health insurers to note on their insurance cards whether the plan is fully insured or self-funded.*

*This act became effective January 1, 2022, and applies to contracts entered into, amended, or renewed on or after that date.*

**BILL ANALYSIS:** The act requires health benefit plans, including the State Health Plan, to state on their insurance cards whether the plan is fully insured or self-funded.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act became effective January 1, 2022, and applies to contracts entered into, amended, or renewed on or after that date.
