OVERVIEW: *Senate Bill 311 would prohibit employers from imposing a waiting period on law enforcement officers who are eligible for membership in the Local Governmental Employees' Retirement System (LGERS).*

BILL ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 311 would prevent employers who participate in LGERS from imposing a waiting period on law enforcement officers who are eligible to become members of the system.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This bill would be effective July 1, 2021.
