OVERVIEW: Section 12.5 of S.L. 2021-158 clarifies that the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources (DNCR) may recognize gifts by naming exhibits, features, or programs administered by DNCR.

This section became effective September 16, 2021.

CURRENT LAW/BILL ANALYSIS:

DNCR has the authority to accept gifts, devises, and endowments for purposes that fall within DNCR's general legal powers and duties.

Section 12.5 of S.L. 2021-158 clarifies that DNCR may recognize gifts by naming exhibits, features, or programs administered by DNCR.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective September 16, 2021.
