OVERVIEW: Senate Bill 574 would allow the owner of a life insurance policy to change the beneficiary if the beneficiary was selected under fraudulent circumstances or false pretenses.

## **BILL ANALYSIS:**

**Section 1** would prohibit a life insurance company from preventing the owner of a policy from changing the beneficiary of the policy if the beneficiary was selected under fraudulent circumstances or false pretenses.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to life insurance policies issued, renewed, or amended on or after that date.
