



SENATE BILL 762: North Carolina Farm Act of 2022, Sec. 5: Farmed Cervid Assessment Clarification

OVERVIEW: Section 5 of S.L. 2022-55 specifies that farmed cervid feed means commercial feed sold to a cervid farmer for farmed cervid use, rather than commercial feed labeled or marketed for farmed cervid use.

This section became effective July 8, 2022.

CURRENT LAW AND BILL ANALYSIS: Section 5 of S.L. 2022-55 makes a clarifying change to the definition of "farmed cervid feed" for purposes of the farmed cervid assessment. This section specifies that farmed cervid feed means commercial feed sold to a cervid farmer for farmed cervid use, rather than commercial feed labeled or marketed for farmed cervid use. Commercial feed for cervids is often labeled for hunting purposes rather than farming.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section of the act became effective July 8, 2022.
