Analysis of: PCS to First Edition Staff Attorney

OVERVIEW: The proposed committee substitute (PCS) to Senate Bill 815 would authorize the City Manager of the City of Shelby to appoint the City Clerk and Treasurer.

CURRENT LAW: Every municipality must have a city clerk (G.S. 160A-171) and a finance officer who also may be referred to as the treasurer (G.S. 159-24). The Charter of the City of Shelby provides that the governing board appoints the city clerk and the treasurer.

BILL ANALYSIS: The PCS to Senate Bill 815 would authorize the City Manager of the City of Shelby, rather than the governing board, to appoint the City Clerk and Treasurer.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The act would be effective when the bill becomes law.
