OVERVIEW: Section 11.3 of S.L. 2024-51 authorizes the Department of Transportation to utilize various alternative project delivery methodologies for the repair and replacement of transportation infrastructure damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Helene.

This section became effective October 10, 2024.

CURRENT LAW/BILL ANALYSIS:

Currently, the Department of Transportation utilizes various project delivery methods to undertake transportation infrastructure projects, some of which may include different limitations and project caps based on method.

Notwithstanding these limitations, Section 11.3 of S.L. 2024-51 authorizes the Department of Transportation to utilize the following project delivery methodologies for the repair and replacement of transportation infrastructure damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Helene in affected counties outlined in Section 4.1 of S.L. 2024-51.

- Progressive design build.
- Design build.
- Design bid build.
- Indefinite delivery indefinite quantity.
- Construction manager general contractor.
