OVERVIEW: Section 1 of S.L. 2023-70 increases the number of gubernatorial appointments to the Board of Trustees of the North Carolina Museum of Art to 14 to reflect the current number of congressional districts in the State, increasing the total number of board members to 26.

## This section became effective June 30, 2023.

**BACKGROUND / BILL ANALYSIS:** Prior to the enactment of S.L. 2023-70, the Board of Trustees of the North Carolina Museum of Art consisted of 25 members, appointed as follows: 13 members—one from each congressional district—appointed by the Governor; four appointed by the Board of Trustees of the North Carolina Museum of Art; four appointed by the North Carolina Museum of Art Foundation, Inc.; and four appointed by the General Assembly, two upon the recommendation of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and two upon the recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

**Section 1** of S.L. 2023-70 increases the number of gubernatorial appointments to the Board of Trustees of the North Carolina Museum of Art to 14 to reflect the current number of congressional districts in the State, increasing the total number of board members to 26.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This section became effective June 30, 2023.
