OVERVIEW: House Bill 180 would designate Haywood County as the official elk capital of the State of North Carolina.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 180 would add a new section in Chapter 145 designating Haywood County as the official elk capital of the State of North Carolina.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The act would be effective when it becomes law.
