OVERVIEW: *Section 7.74 of S.L. 2023-134 requires the State Board of Education to grant a continuing professional license (CPL) to a teacher who meets the following criteria:*

- *Is licensed in a state that has substantially similar licensure requirements as North Carolina.*
- *Has at least three years of teaching experience.*
- *Is in good standing with the other state.*

This section became effective October 3, 2023, and applies to out-of-state applicants for a CPL on or after that date.
