OVERVIEW: Section 20.4 of S.L. 2023-134 expands the definitions of the terms "minority business" and "historically underutilized business" for public contracting purposes.

This section became effective October 3, 2023, and applies to contracts awarded on or after that date.

CURRENT LAW: Article 8 of Chapter 143 outlines the laws that relate to various types of public contracts, which include a verifiable minority business and historically underutilized business participation goal in public building projects.

BILL ANALYSIS: Section 20.4 of S.L. 2023-134 expands the definitions of the terms "minority business" and "historically underutilized business" to include employee stock ownership plan companies in which at least 51% of the stock is owned by persons in eligible groups.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective October 3, 2023, and applies to contracts awarded on or after that date.
