OVERVIEW: *House Bill 361 would require the designated Protection and Advocacy Agency ("Agency") for the State to submit quarterly reports on actions the Agency has taken to advocate for persons with disabilities.*

BILL ANALYSIS:

House Bill 361 would require the Agency to submit quarterly reports on actions taken to advocate for persons with disabilities.

The General Assembly would be encouraged to examine the Agency's activities for impact on current and future State budgets.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act would be effective when it became law.

BACKGROUND: Disability Rights North Carolina is the federally designated protection and advocacy agency for the State and is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization.

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
