OVERVIEW: HB 38 would require the State Board of Education to adopt rules requiring that cash be accepted for admission to any high school athletic event.

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 115C-12(23) and Article 29E of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes require that the State Board of Education (SBE) establish rules governing interscholastic athletic activities. G.S. 115C-47(4) requires local boards of education to conduct interscholastic athletic activities in accordance with SBE rules.

BILL ANALYSIS: HB 38 would require the SBE to establish a rule for high school interscholastic athletic activities to require cash be accepted as a form of payment for admission to any activity where an admissions fee is charged.

EFFECTIVE DATE: HB 38 would become effective when it becomes law and would apply beginning with the 2023-2024 school year.
