OVERVIEW: Section 51 of S.L. 2023-137 makes technical corrections to the appointment criteria for the Residential Code Council, which was created by S.L. 2023-108.

This bill was vetoed by the Governor on October 2, 2023, and that veto was overridden by the General Assembly on October 10, 2023. This section becomes effective on January 1, 2025.

BILL ANALYSIS:

S.L. 2023-108 created a Residential Code Council, with 13 members appointed by the Governor and the General Assembly. The section of S.L. 2023-108 creating this Council does not become effective until January 1, 2025, and no appointments have been made.

Section 51 makes technical corrections to the appointment criteria for the members appointed by the General Assembly.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This bill was vetoed by the Governor on October 2, 2023, and that veto was overridden by the General Assembly on October 10, 2023. This section becomes effective on January 1, 2025.
