OVERVIEW: House Bill 89 would adopt the Moravian cookie as the official State cookie and the Moravian Star as the official State star.

CURRENT LAW: State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official cookie or official star.

BILL ANALYSIS: The bill would amend Chapter 145 of the General Statutes by adding two new sections to establish the Moravian cookie as the official cookie of the State of North Carolina and the Moravian star as the official star of the State of North Carolina.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act would be effective when it becomes law.
