

## SENATE BILL 332: 2023 Appropriations Act Changes.

OVERVIEW: The Proposed Committee Substitute (PCS) for Senate Bill 332 modifies the Current Operations Appropriations Act of 2023 (S.L. 2023-134) by authorizing various salary increases for the 2024-2025 fiscal year.

## **BILL ANALYSIS:**

- **Section 1.1** enacts the Teacher Salary Schedule for 2024-2025 and authorizes an average three percent (3%) raise.
- **Section 1.2** enacts the Principal Salary Schedule for 2024-2025 and authorizes an average three percent (3%) raise.
- Section 1.3 authorizes bonuses for principals in the 2024-2025 fiscal year.
- Section 1.4 authorizes salaries for assistant principals in the 2024-2025 fiscal year and continues to tie those salaries to the Teacher Salary Schedule plus nineteen percent (19%), which amounts to an average two and three-tenths percent (2.3%) raise.
- Section 1.5 authorizes a three percent (3%) raise for central office employees and an associated increase in maximum salaries.
- Section 1.6 authorizes a three percent (3%) raise for noncertified personnel.
- **Section 1.7** authorizes certain State agency personnel that are paid under the Teacher Salary Schedule to be paid based upon the new schedule.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act would become effective July 1, 2024.
