OVERVIEW: Section 1 of S.L. 2024-32 amends various definitions of "agriculture," "agricultural operation," and related terms to clarify that those terms include the boarding of horses.

This section became effective July 3, 2024.

BILL ANALYSIS:

In 2022, the definition of agricultural land for purposes of present-use value taxation was updated to explicitly state that it includes the boarding of horses.

Section 1 of S.L. 2024-32 amends various definitions of "agriculture," "agricultural operation," and related terms to clarify that those terms include the boarding of horses.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective July 3, 2024.
