

SENATE BILL 355: Clarify Definition/Property-Hauling Vehicles.

OVERVIEW: Senate Bill 355 would clarify that a fifth-wheel trailer, recreational vehicle, semitrailer, or trailer used exclusively or primarily to transport vehicles in connection with motorsports competition events is not considered a property-hauling vehicle.

CURRENT LAW AND BACKGROUND: Property-hauling vehicles have different rates for taxation and registration than passenger vehicles. Law enforcement officers may seize and detain property-hauling vehicles in certain circumstances provided in <u>G.S. 20-96</u>, such as overloading or failing to have proper registration plates. Window tinting restrictions do not apply to the rear window of a property-hauling vehicle.

BILL ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 355 would clarify that a fifth-wheel trailer, recreational vehicle, semitrailer, or trailer used exclusively or primarily to transport vehicles in connection with motorsports competition events is not considered a property-hauling vehicle.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act would be effective when it becomes law.
