OVERVIEW: Section 1D.6 of S.L. 2024-57 provides that temporary pump and haul wastewater permits issued to a temporary housing unit in an affected area remain valid for 12 months, with an option to extend the permit for no more than 12 months, provided the permit holder complies with certain requirements related to septage management, public health, and environmental protection, including a quarterly reporting requirement.

This bill was vetoed by the Governor on November 26, 2024, and that veto was overridden by the General Assembly on December 11, 2024. This section of the act became effective December 11, 2024, and applies to permits issued through March 1, 2025.
