Extend Certain Concealed Handgun Permits

OVERVIEW: Section 1E.1 of S.L. 2024-57 provides that any concealed handgun permit issued pursuant to Article 54B of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes to a resident of a county designated under a federal major disaster declaration as a result of Hurricane Helene, with an expiration date on or after September 25, 2024, but no later than December 31, 2024, remains valid until March 1, 2025.

This bill was vetoed by the Governor on November 26, 2024, and that veto was overridden by the General Assembly on December 11, 2024. This section of the act became effective December 11, 2024.
